

COOKIE POLICY

We use 'cookies' on the website operated by the Dorcas Ministries at <https://www.dorcas.hu> to ensure the most efficient operation of our website and to improve the services intended for visitors. Some of the 'cookies' we use are essential for the proper functioning of certain services, while others collect information about the use of the website (statistics) to create an even more convenient and useful site. Some 'cookies' are temporary and disappear when the browser is closed, but there are also persistent versions that remain on your computer for a while. Some cookies are placed and read by third parties.

Some 'cookies' are essential for the operation of the site, while others are used to enhance performance and user experience.

DEFINITIONS FOUND IN THE POLICY

Data Subject: Any natural person identified or identifiable based on any information processed by the Data Controller.

Personal Data: Any information related to an identified or identifiable natural person ("Data Subject"). An identifiable natural person is one who can be identified directly or indirectly, especially by an identifier such as a name, number, location data, online identifier, or factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural, or social identity of the natural person.

Data Processing: Any operation or set of operations performed on personal data or datasets, whether automated or non-automated, such as collection, recording, organization, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination, or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, restriction, erasure, or destruction.

WHAT ARE "COOKIES"?

A 'cookie' is a text information package (text file) that the web server serving the website, possibly during the first visit, sends and places on your device (whether it is a computer, smartphone, tablet, etc.) to store information about the user, the operation of the website, or the relationship between the user and the web server.

Through storing, when you return to the same website from the same device, your browser communicates with the web server, recognizes that you have visited the page before, and can provide information accordingly.

HOW DO WE USE "COOKIES"?

The "cookies" used on the website operated by the Dorcas Ministries at <https://www.dorkasz.hu> are necessary "cookies" for the optimal operation of the website.

PERSISTENT "COOKIES"

These cookies:

- assist in navigating the website, remember the visitor's actions on certain pages, and recognize the visitor when logging into the website,
- do not store information about the visitor's internet browsing history or information that could be used for marketing purposes, and do not store personal data
- remain on the visitor's device for the duration specified in the "cookies" and are activated each time the visitor visits the website.

SESSION "COOKIES"

Among the "cookies," there are those essential for the operation of the website and some of its functions, for website navigation. To facilitate personalized service and the login process, the system identifies the visitor's computer with a 'session cookie.' If the visitor only closes the browser window, the logged-in status is retained when reopening the browser window. These "cookies" do not collect information about the visitor that could identify them (personal data) or be used for marketing purposes, nor do they remember the visitor's activities on other websites or subpages of the website.

ANALYTICAL "COOKIES"

To create visit and usage statistics, we use Google Analytics, which utilizes "cookies" to perform its tasks. Google Analytics is a third-party software that collects only aggregated, anonymous data on how visitors use our website. The aggregated anonymous data is used for statistical analysis, providing information such as the average time spent on the website or measuring popularity. Google Analytics does not handle any personal data provided by you, and it does not identify you personally in any form. THIRD-PARTY COOKIES

These cookies are placed and read by third parties in connection with the options offered on our website. We have limited knowledge and supervision over the data collected and the purposes for which such data is used. These third-party cookies may be functional, strictly necessary, or analytical cookies. Third parties may use the collected information for their own purposes. The collected information may include, among other things, information about how you use the options provided by the respective third parties and may allow the third party to recognize the user. For more information on these cookies and how third parties use the collected information, follow the links provided or contact the respective third party.

FACEBOOK "COOKIES"

For the purpose of improving the user experience, the website includes Facebook tools that use "cookies" to fulfill their tasks. These tools are third-party software managed by Facebook, providing social interaction possibilities and collecting statistical data. FACEBOOK REMARKETING

We use the so-called "Facebook pixel" operated by Facebook Inc. (1 Hacker Way, Menlo Park, CA 94025, USA), or if you are in the EU, by Facebook Ireland Ltd. (4 Grand Canal Square, Grand Canal

Harbour, Dublin 2, Ireland). The Facebook pixel allows Facebook to treat visitors to the website as a target audience for displaying advertisements (Facebook ads). We use the Facebook pixel to ensure that embedded Facebook ads appear only to Facebook users who have shown interest in our offers. This is to ensure that Facebook ads match the potential interests of users and are not disruptive. The Facebook pixel also allows us to analyze the effectiveness of our advertisements on Facebook for statistical and market research purposes, as it helps determine whether users reached our website by clicking on a Facebook ad.

The Facebook pixel is embedded when the website is opened, placing a small file (cookie) on the device. If you later log in to Facebook or visit Facebook pages while logged in, your visit to our website is registered in your profile. The information obtained about you is anonymous to us, and we cannot identify your identity based on it. However, Facebook stores and processes the data, making it linkable to the specific user profile. Facebook handles the data according to its own privacy policy. You can prevent data collection by the Facebook pixel and the use of your data for displaying Facebook ads by adjusting your settings. These settings are platform-independent and apply to both desktop and mobile devices.

COOKIES USED BY OUR SERVER

1. Persistent cookie - IDE
 - These advertising cookies are stored in Google DoubleClick and customize ads displayed to users based on their previous visits to our website.
 - *Duration:* 1 year
2. Persistent cookie - PHPSESSID
 - Stores the logged-in user and the 128-bit encrypted key. This information is necessary for the user to log in to a website anytime without re-entering their username and password on every visited page. Without this cookie, the user cannot proceed to authenticated access sites.
 - *Duration:* 1 day
3. Remarketing cookie (Facebook) - _fbp
 - *Description:* This cookie helps our ads reach those who have already visited our website when they are on Facebook or on a digital platform operating with Facebook ads.
 - *Duration:* 3 months
4. Marketing cookie, third-party cookie - fr
 - *Description:* Used by Facebook to deliver ads to the user, such as ads based on third-party offers. It also allows checking the "Follow us on Facebook" and "Like" buttons.
 - *Duration:* 3 months
5. Marketing cookie, third-party cookie - dpr
 - *Description:* Facebook uses these cookies to support social sharing and the integration of Facebook services.
 - *Duration:* 1 week

6. Analytics cookie - Google Analytics `_ga`
 - *Description:* Used for measuring traffic on our website. It stores a single text string in the browser for identifying interactions and the browser/source page that led the user to our website. No personal data is saved.
 - *Duration:* 2 years
7. Analytics cookie - Google Analytics `_gat_gtag_UA_188374793_1`
 - *Description:* Used to regulate the request rate, limiting data collection on high-traffic pages.
 - *Duration:* 1 minute
8. Analytics cookie - Google Analytics `_gcl_au`
 - *Description:* Used by Google to display a range of advertising products, such as real-time bidding for third-party advertisers.
 - *Duration:* 3 months
9. Analytics cookie - Google Analytics `_gid`
 - *Description:* Serves to store session identifiers and collect all session activities for individual users.
 - *Duration:* 1 day
10. Persistent cookie - CONSENT
 - *Description:* Necessary cookies for Google Maps, according to Google.com's privacy statement.
 - *Duration:* 20 years
11. Persistent cookie - NID
 - *Description:* A setting cookie unique to most Google users' browsers, containing an identifier for Google.hu service. It remembers preferences and other information.
 - *Duration:* 6 months
12. Persistent cookie - `_Secure-3PAPISID`
 - *Description:* Used for targeting purposes to create profiles of website visitors' interests for displaying relevant and personalized Google ads.
 - *Duration:* 2 years
13. Persistent cookie - `_Secure-3PSID`
 - *Description:* Used for targeting purposes to create profiles of website visitors' interests for displaying relevant and personalized Google ads.
 - *Duration:* 2 years
14. Persistent cookie - `_Secure-3PSIDCC`
 - *Description:* Used for targeting purposes to create profiles of website visitors' interests for displaying relevant and personalized Google ads.
 - *Duration:* 1 year
15. Third-party cookie - `ts`
 - *Description:* Provided by Paypal, used in connection with transactions on the website. Necessary for secure transactions.
 - *Duration:* 2 years
16. Third-party cookie - `ts_c`
 - *Description:* Provided by Paypal, used in connection with transactions on the website. Necessary for secure transactions.
 - *Duration:* 3 years

17. Third-party cookie - akavpau_ppsd

- *Description:* Provided by Paypal, used in connection with transactions on the website. Necessary for secure transactions.
- *Validity until session end*

YOUR CONSENT

By browsing the website and pressing the "I ACCEPT" button, you agree that we place "cookies" on your computer for the purpose of providing a suitable and secure user experience.

HOW TO WITHDRAW CONSENT?

If you have given consent to the use of "cookies," your browser stores cookies on your computer or other device to recognize your settings. The validity of the consent expires from time to time. However, if you wish to withdraw your consent before the expiration date, you can do so at any time in your browser's cookie settings.

HOW TO DELETE/DISABLE "COOKIES"?

Every browser allows changes to the settings related to "cookie" preferences. However, since the purpose of "cookies" is to facilitate the usability and processes of the website, preventing or deleting the application of "cookies" may result in the user being unable to fully use the website's functions or the website not working as intended in your browser.

Generally, the settings related to "cookies" can be found in the browsers/Settings menus. The following links provide information on the settings for "cookies" in the most popular browsers. Additional information can also be found in the Help menu of each browser.

HOGYAN LEHET TÖRÖLNI/KIKAPCSOLNI A „SÜTIKET” COOKIE-KAT?

Minden böngésző lehetővé teszi a „süti” cookie beállításainak változtatását. Mivel azonban a „sütik” cookie-k célja a weboldal használhatóságának és folyamatainak megkönnyítése, a „sütik” cookie-k alkalmazásának megakadályozása vagy törlése esetén előfordulhat, hogy a felhasználó nem lesz képes a weboldal funkcióinak teljes körű használatára, illetve, hogy a weboldal a tervezettől eltérően fog működni böngészőjében.
